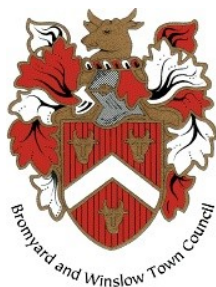

FILMING AND RECORDING OF COUNCIL MEETINGS
