General Property & Maintenance Update

To provide members with an update detailing the work carried out by the council.

General

Our contractor has planted winter planting in the containers around the Town.

In association with Tim Cronin of West Midlands Ambulance Service, a Blood Kit has been installed in the defibrillator box by the Public Hall. This life saving kit is registered with the ambulance service, so anyone requiring it in an emergency is directed to it.

Herefordshire Council is proposing a new grant scheme for energy audits and heat decarbonization of Public Buildings. We will complete the expression of interest form to be kept informed when this grant becomes available.

Old Vicarage

The Citizens Advice Bureau held their first drop-in clinic at The Old Vicarage on 28th October. This first session was successful, and these sessions will continue to run fortnightly through to Christmas.

We have received notice from one office tenant at The Old Vicarage. This room will become available in December.

Heritage Centre & Old Vicarage Complex

The Town Green and paths have been mown and leaves cleared by the contractors in time for the Remembrance services.

Tenbury Road Car Park & Toilets

Electric Vehicle Charging –options for rapid charging in Tenbury Road Car park are actively being considered.

Cemetery

The new water supply pipe will be installed during November/December. We are awaiting a date from the contractor.
