B23/12 Garden of Peace

1. Workhouse Memorial

To consider and approve the updated design plans for the memorial sculpture, as prepared by Mr Adrian Legge.

 - b) 4x Populus tremula (common aspen) tree for the garden along the roadside boundary.

IT WAS RESOLVED to accept the offer from Herefordshire Council to plant the above 5 trees at Broadbridge.

B23/13 Seating / benches

Members considered a request for the purchase and installation of a memorial bench in memory of the late Mr Dave Morris. The bench will be installed in the top part of the cemetery, close to the new cremation area.

IT WAS RESOLVED to approve this request and to specify that the new bench is constructed from durable materials which are low maintenance and resistant to vandalism and weather. A brown slatted Lowther seat, supplied by Glasdon UK, was approved.

B23/14 Cemetery Maintenance

Members considered any maintenance issues in the cemetery and Garden of Peace that may require action.

No immediate actions were identified. Members of the committee will attend a site visit to the cemetery in May where all aspects of cemetery maintenance will be considered.
