They offer support to fellow organisers with equipment, technical and legal issues - *Party in the Park, Scarecrow Festival, Bromyard Pride, Bromyard MAD, Nozstock, Bromyard Speed Festival, Artwalk, Folk Festival, Christmas Lights Switch-on and Christmas Tree Festival.*

For many years the Bromyard Festivals Association has been putting up bunting in the town centre. This is put up around April before the first of the festivals and remains until after the Folk Festival in September. The Town Council have kindly paid for this in previous years and volunteers have taken the responsibility to put them up, remove and store during the winter. The Town Council kindly gave a grant for bunting back in 2023.

Bromyard's festivals bring in many visitors to the town, benefiting local businesses, who would struggle even more without the extra footfall.

Residents also benefit by having these events taking place in their town, particularly children, who are poorly served, compared to other towns in the area.

The Festivals Association were to apply for a grant for the bunting and 5000 leaflets, which are distributed to over 60 venues over the region. We have found a sponsor for the leaflets, so we are asking for funding for just the bunting, which we are getting at a discounted rate of 0.75p per metre instead of £1.00 per metre. We will be supplying the labour to erect and remove the bunting and maintain over from April to September.
